


### Response to Applicant Form 4A

Re: Your request for access to information under Part II of the **Access to**Information and Protection of Privacy Act, 2015 [Our File # 2023-10]

On May 2, 2023, the Town of Paradise received your request for access to the following records/information:

I am looking for any correspondence between the Town employees, Town Council and residents of Paradise concerning chicken(s) in Elizabeth Park, specifically in the neighborhood of Canterbury, Drummond, and Hillsdale area.

I am pleased to inform you that a decision has been made by the ATIPP Coordinator for the Town of Paradise to provide access to the requested information.

Access to some information contained within the records, has been refused in accordance with the following exception(s) to disclosure, as specified in the Access to Information and Protection of Privacy Act, 2015 (the Act):

Disclosure harmful to personal privacy

40. (1) the head of a public body shall refuse to disclose personal information to an applicant where the disclosure would be an unreasonable invasion of a third party's personal privacy.

Please be advised that you may ask the Information and Privacy Commissioner to review the processing of your access request, as set out in section 42 of the Access to

We have had an ongoing issue with rats

Hillsdale Cres.

We have tried traps and pest control poison etc. The rats became worse as the land was cleared up from the area (kenmount business park) and our neighbors have a compost and chickens that also provide additional food source We spent additional money and labor last spring dug up all around our decks in the back yard and put down metal flashing trying to keep the rats out.

The rats dug under our concrete foundation (garage) and tunnels though our garden.

We invest time and money every year to maintain and improve our property, dealing with rodents takes away from the enjoyment of our property, I'm afraid to go down to my back yard at night.

The low water pressure in our area is another concern....

We pay one of the highest property tax within the town of paradise and simply do not see the services justifying this

Hi Councillor Street:

We have received a number of similar written complaints from people in Elizabeth Park today. Seems to be a coordinated effort.

The Town has been baiting the area near Hillsdale due to a number of complaints. A cause of the rodent activity has yet to be determined, but there has been a lot of tree cover removed on the St. John's side of the municipal boundary in this area of late.

This person does not mention chicken coops but others have. Has someone provided you with civic addresses for the chicken coops in question? If so, please forward to me. We will be sending Development Control staff to investigate.

Many residents in the neighbourhood are having problems and I personally have been dealing with this issue I moved no issues with rodents at any time. I have caught between 40-50 rats in traps over the past year and a half. It seems to be a never ending issue and I cannot get ahead of it. The town of Paradise have provided pest control services for several of our homes but it does not appear to be having any effect on the rodent problems. A couple of days rat on his front step that actually jumped at him before running under the patio. My yard is full of rat holes and it's to the point not go in the backyard.

Can the town please make an effort to address this issue as our neighbourhood is overrun with rodents and it's only a matter of time before we have them inside our homes.
